### Tickets

Tickets are available for purchase starting **Monday, May 5 through the High Point Theatre Box Office.** Each student is entitled to 2 free tickets. **Additional tickets are \$15 per person.**

### Recital Videos

Recital flash drives will be available for \$35 each. We have a new videographer this year with a great deal. You will get both June 9 and June 10 shows AND they will take pictures during show. You will get all of that for \$35! Personal recording and flash photography will not be allowed at the performances, because this is distracting and dangerous to our performers. Recital videos are filmed and edited by a professional videographer, so please allow 6-8 weeks for editing, production and delivery of the videos. You can place order for video anytime between now and recital.

### Recital T-Shirts

Orders are due by **Saturday, May 3.** The shirt will be Grey and have our theme, *Back In Time 25 Years* on the front and the names of the performing students on the back. Short-sleeve t-shirts are \$25.

**T-Shirt orders must be turned in on time.** No extra shirts will be ordered. You can text Holly your orders - Name & what size. If ordering multiple shirts give all names/sizes.

You will not be dancing in class, but will be taking pictures only. **REMEMBER TO BRING YOUR COSTUME, ACCESSORIES, TIGHTS AND DANCE SHOES!** Have your hair & make up fixed according to the Hair/Make-up description in your costume grocery bag. The photographer will take a group shot and take individual pictures to be purchased. Picture envelopes are available in office. Private Music Students can also take pictures.

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## Names/Costumes

It is very important to make sure that the student's name is inside all shoes and costumes. This is especially important at performance time so that the students have what they need to go on stage. We can also identify items from other students. Please check your child's shoes to ensure they fit properly for the performance. Make sure that if your child brings a bag, it zips so things do not fall out and get lost.

## Dress Rehearsal

There is a separate Dress Rehearsal schedule for each Recital.

All students **must** attend dress rehearsal in order to perform in the recital. Attendance is very important to ensure that everyone has a successful performance.

Student(s) need to be dropped off with the Triple Threat staff member at the side door of the High Point Theatre, located on S Hamilton St.

**Parents are not allowed to stay backstage or in the audience. Parent will go to the lobby to wait.** There will be assigned teachers and helpers to take the students to their proper dressing areas, during both the dress rehearsal and the recital. There will also be

teachers and helpers assigned to supervise and assist your children.

Once your child has rehearsed each dance they are participating in, they may have a snack and something to drink and then will wait for the show to start. We will bring the younger students out to the lobby to meet their parent.

**Please be at the High Point Theatre for your scheduled time slot, dressed and ready to go on stage. This includes your costume, dance shoes, and hair as they will need to be for the Recital.**

**A Dress Rehearsal Schedule has been texted to you. WE WILL BE ON A TIGHT SCHEDULE AND CANNOT WAIT ON DANCERS WHO ARE LATE TO DRESS REHEARSAL. PLEASE BE EARLY AND READY TO DANCE SO YOU DO NOT MISS YOUR DRESS REHEARSAL!!**

Performers need to be backstage by 4:30pm. Show starts at 5:30pm.

Monday at 6:00pm  
(Be backstage by 5:00pm.)  
Tuesday at 5:30pm  
(Be backstage by 4:30pm.)

There will be teachers and volunteers to help get your child where they need to be as well as supervise and assist them backstage. All performers must stay backstage during the recital.

All younger performers will be released from the Gallery after the show.

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## **Dos and Don'ts of Dance Recital. Please Review with Child!!!**

- No underwear under costumes.
- No nail polish on fingers or toes.
- No jewelry.
- No gum.
- No sodas allowed back stage. You may want to bring a water bottle and a non-messy snack. We do not want food or drink to be spilled on costumes or in the Dressing Room.
- Hair and Make-up fixed as specified in class and your costume description.
- Performers should have pink leather ballet shoes, half soles, black jazz shoes, and black tap shoes. Refer to your costume sheet.
- Make sure your shoes are in good condition and fit.
- Make sure you have all the pieces to your costumes. If you lose something there are no extras so you may not be able to perform.
- Make sure your name is in all of your shoes and costume pieces.
- Always act appropriately on and off stage.
- Please be quiet on and off stage.
- Stretch and warm-up before you perform.
- If you are not dressing or helping a younger class, wait in your dressing area out of the other performers' way. We have some students who have quick changes.
- No performers should be in the audience except for the classes released at intermission. The performers released at intermission who return to the audience to enjoy the rest of the show MUST be **out of costume and in regular street clothes.**
- Performers need to be responsible and organized!! Keep all of your things together.
- No Parents backstage during the Recital. Drop off students at the designated area. Just follow the signs. There are teachers and helpers responsible for the younger classes.
- Most importantly work as a team and be respectful of everyone!
